Withdrawal of Exemption Request to Use Amendment 1 to CoC 1030

Reference: Florida Power and Light Company letter L-2010-256 dated November 5, 2010, "Request for Exemptions from 10 CFR 72.212(b)(2)(i)(A), and 10 CFR 72.212(b)(7) requiring compliance with NUHOMS<sup>®</sup> HD Certificate of Compliance No. 1030 Amendment No. 0 for Spent Fuel Storage Casks, 10 CFR 72.48, 10 CFR 72.212(a)(2) and 10 CFR 72.214"

Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) requested exemptions from certain requirements specified in 10 CFR 72 in the above reference. The exemptions were requested to use Amendment No. 1 to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1030 for the Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 independent spent fuel storage installation initial fuel loading campaigns currently scheduled to begin in July 2011. Because Amendment No. 1 to CoC No. 1030 was made effective on March 29, 2011 the exemption is no longer needed. Therefore, FPL withdraws the referenced exemption request.
