Dear Mr. Murley:

On behalf of The Alabama Conservancy and its Board of Directors, I'd like to express our concern and dismay over recent reports about the Quadrex Corporation and its plans to lease, complete construction, and operate the Bellefonte nuclear power complex.

It seems clear that Quadrex is financially and technically unqualified to make such a move. This action would threaten the health and safety of Alabamians and the citizens of neighboring states. Furthermore, it offers them none of the benefits of the plants operation.

If and when any license transfer hearings or operating license hearings are scheduled, The Alabama Conservancy would like to enter them. We are aware that a notice of the opportunity for intervention has not yet been issued; and this is not a formal petition to intervene. The intent of this letter is to inform you, in advance, of our intentions.
