Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(f), this letter provides BLN's response to GL 92-01, Revision 1, Supplement 1. This GL supplement requests additional assurance from licensees that all relevant data has been obtained and evaluated to assess compliance with reactor pressure vessel structural integrity requirements.

When GL 92-01, Revision 1 was issued, BLN was in deferral status and as a result did not prepare a response. TVA is presently engaged in an Integrated Resource Planning (IRP) process to consider the least cost options for providing an adequate supply of electricity to TVA's customers. As part of this planning process, TVA is evaluating the completion of the BLN units along with other generating options. Consequently, the completion schedule for BLN is currently undefined and the analyses required to demonstrate compliance with reactor vessel structural integrity requirements have not been completed.

BLN will provide a complete response to GL 92-01, Revision 1 and Supplement 1 prior to fuel load on each respective unit.

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

