Caribbean Quality Control Services requested termination of its license and indicated that the gauges will be transferred to Jaca & Sierra Testing Laboratories. I noticed that Caribbean Quality Control possessed CPN and Troxler gauges that they were planning to transfer to Jaca & Sierra Testing Laboratories.

Jaca & Sierra Testing Laboratories' license only authorizes CPN gauges and its renewal application also did not request addition of Troxler gauges. Therefore, I called Carlos Sierra (President) to remind him that their license does not authorize Troxler gauges and that they must not acquire any gauge that is not authorized on the license before requesting and receiving an amendment to their license.

Carlos stated that a final decision to acquire gauges from Caribbean Quality Control has not been made and that he was aware of the requirement to have the license amended and the gauges tested for leakage prior to acquiring the gauges. He also stated that if he decides to acquire the gauges, he will take his consultant (David Rhoe) with him to Virgin Islands so that he can check the gauges and test them for leakage.
