- (1) The agency's excepted functions are addressed in Section II of the Handbook accompanying the NRC document, "Contingency Plan for Periods of Lapsed Appropriations," a copy of which is enclosed with this letter.
- (2) The agency did not prepare a list of employees who would be retained during a lapse of appropriations since a lapse in appropriations did not occur on April 9. Sections III and Exhibit 1 of the Handbook mentioned above call for developing the list after a lapse in appropriations during the time the NRC is operating using unobligated prior year funds.
- (3) The agency's minimum expectations for communicating information regarding a shutdown to its employees also are addressed in the enclosed document (see Section III and Exhibit 1 of the Handbook). Beyond this, the agency believes in regular communications with all employees, and has been providing additional weekly or more frequent messages regarding the possible lapse in appropriations. This has included several messages from the NRC Chairman (both video and written communication) and frequent updates from me.
