**TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY (TVA) – SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) –
NPDES PERMIT NO. TN0026450 – ALTERNATIVE THERMAL LIMIT (ATL) STUDY
PLAN EXTENSION REQUEST**

Part III, Section F of the subject permit requires a study plan be developed to support continuation of SQN's ATL under Section 316(a) of the Clean Water Act and submitted by April 29, 2011. TVA met with the division on April 7, 2011, to discuss comments on a proposed balanced indigenous community (BIC) study plan developed for Bull Run Fossil Plant. Since the division's comments are also applicable to SQN, TVA wishes to incorporate these changes into SQN's BIC study plan prior to submitting.

TVA requests that the date of submittal for SQN's BIC study plan be extended an additional 45-days to June 14, 2011. We request your concurrence with this extension request.
