Dear Ms. McGinley,

This is in reference to your letter dated February 16, 2011 requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 37-00261-04, Docket No. 030-15060. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. We received your letter dated March 29, 2011, and noted two sources that failed leak test. In your letter to us on April 24, 2008, you wrote that the sources were is a storage area and the results of testing showed no removable contamination in the storage area. Please send us a copy of the survey that was performed.
2. The block, "Mail all future correspondence regarding this license to," on Form NRC 314, Certificate of Disposition of Materials was left blank. Please state where all future correspondence should be sent or state that future correspondence should be mailed to MSA's current address.
3. You were licensed for Am-241 sources but did not submit any leak tests for Am-241 sources. Please confirm that you did not have any Am-241 sources at temporary job sites within NRC jurisdiction, that those sources did not meet the criteria for leak testing, or provide leak tests for the Am-241 sources.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office and refer to Mail Control No. 574473. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.
