Gentlemen:

Pursuant to section 105(c) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, information requested by the Attorney General for the conduct of his anti-trust review and rendering of advice to the Commission with respect to facility license applications is required to be furnished by all applicants. The information requested by the Attorney General is enclosed.

We understand that you intend to file a construction permit application for a new nuclear power plant during the next few months. Please submit the information desired by the Attorney General as a separate document titled "Information Requested by the Attorney General for Antitrust Review." It is requested that twenty (20) copies be submitted with the license application and not less than twenty-five (25) additional copies be retained by you to be available as needed during the antitrust review.

Since nearly all electric power sales by your system are to wholesale rather than retail customers, the Department of Justice did not require answers to some of the enclosed questions with respect to the Watts Bar construction permit application. When submitting the requested antitrust information for your new nuclear plant, please identify these questions and indicate that they are not applicable. However, the Department has informed us that complete information is required on expressions of interest for power supply coordination received by TVA from other bulk power suppliers. This information should be furnished in response to Item 13 shown on page 7 of the enclosure.

The antitrust review licensing function of the Atomic Energy Commission has been assigned to the Office of Antitrust and Indemnity. All future correspondence dealing with the antitrust aspects of facility applications should be addressed to this Office.
