SUBJECT: FERMI UNIT 3, COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION – ADVANCED
FINAL SAFETY EVALUATION FOR CHAPTER 18,
“HUMAN FACTORS ENGINEERING”

By letter dated September 18, 2008, Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison) submitted an application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a combined license (COL) for Fermi Unit 3.

Based on our review of the application, the staff is providing the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) its Advanced Final Safety Evaluation (AFSE) for Chapter 18, “Human Factors Engineering” (ML111101066). Unless otherwise stated in the AFSE, the staff’s review was based on Revision 3 of the application. The AFSE is being provided to support a meeting of the subcommittee of the ACRS scheduled for May 26, 2011. The ACRS Full Committee meeting will be held after the subcommittee meeting.

Based on the Memorandum to the Executive Director for Operations dated February 17, 2010 (ML100280052), the staff reviewed the AFSE and found no topics that meet the categories of interest that ACRS members would like to review in detail.

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The staff concludes that the AFSE does not contain any information exempt from public disclosure. However, the NRC will withhold the AFSE from public disclosure for 10 business days to allow Detroit Edison the opportunity to verify the staff's conclusion that the AFSE contains no such exempt information. Therefore, the staff requests that the ACRS withhold the AFSE from public disclosure until the information has been released publicly in ADAMS.

The staff will inform the ACRS immediately if Detroit Edison requests that any of the information in the AFSE be withheld from public disclosure.
