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Overview

- SRM dated March 24, 2011 – Limited scope rulemaking with concurrent implementation guidance (SRM-SECY-11-0003, ML110830971)
- Four months to complete... July 24, 2011
- Endorsement of a Supplement to NEI-06-11 revision 1

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Site Implementation of the MDO Alternative

- To change from the MDO requirements to the 54 rolling average requirements, add a statement to the site's policy and procedures.
- Sites must implement either the MDO or the 54 rolling average but not both concurrently.

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Issues to be Included in Implementation of the MDO Alternative

- How the first weeks of such schedules would be administered e.g. coming out of outages
- How licensees would manage individuals' fatigue on such schedules
 - How consecutive extended work weeks would be minimized
 - How consecutive extended work days would be minimized
 - How individuals' days off would be maintained
- Calculations , e.g. averaging based on a calendar day/week.
