Janet I wanted to let you know that I met with the staff on the proposal to apply ISAs to part 40 licenses. One issue we discussed was the petition you referenced. Apparently the staff is working on a response. The petition requested a change to the part 70 reporting requirements, not the part 40 requirements. The proposed rule conforms part 40 to part 70. So, if we rolled the petition request into the part 40 rulemaking, we would end up with requirements in part 40 and 70 that were different until another rulemaking to revise part 70 was processed. So, my initial thought is perhaps we should process the petition separately and then do a rulemaking to revise both parts 40 and 70 at the same time. The staff are suggesting that we specifically solicit comments on the reporting requirements in the proposed rule. This should flush out any remaining issues. Your thoughts?
