Dear Ms. Kennedy,

As per our phone conversation today, additional information is needed to process the termination request for Cardiology Associates of Waterbury, P.C. Since you have reported that the Nuclear Medicine portion of Cardiology Associates of Waterbury, P.C. has been acquired by Waterbury Hospital Health Center, which has requested that it be added to their license, a transfer of control of activities is appropriate rather than typical activities required to release a facility for unrestricted use. For this reason the additional information needed is outlined in NUREG 1556 Volume 9 Revision 2 and can be found in Appendix G: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v9/r2/sr1556v9r2-final.pdf#app-g>

The additional information we are requesting is as follows:

- Clarify what portions of Cardiology Associates of Waterbury, P.C. have not been acquired by Waterbury Hospital Health Center and confirm that they do not involve USNRC licensed activities.
- Submit a facility diagram that shows all current licensed locations that will be transferred and what activities are conducted in these locations. Include markings as instructed in NUREG 1556

- Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to Waterbury Hospital Health Center.
- Document what licensed material is being transferred to Waterbury Hospital Health Center and confirm that all waste material will be removed prior to the transfer of control.

Once we receive the additional information requested, we should be able to finalize the processing of your license amendment. You may respond to my attention in writing by letter or fax (610-337-5076), referencing mail control 574522. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your amendment.
