On March 23 and 24, 2011, a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspector conducted a routine security inspection with continuing NRC in-office review through April 5, 2011, at the Oakwood Hospital and Medical Center facility located in Dearborn, Michigan. The continuing NRC in-office review related to discussions with your Radiation Safety Officer concerning licensed activities at your facility. A final telephonic exit meeting was held on April 5, 2011.

This inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, orders, and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel.

The preliminary inspection results were discussed with you and members of your staff at the conclusion of the on-site inspection. On April 5, 2011, the final inspection findings were discussed with Dr. Jerry Drake of your staff and Michael LaFranzo of my staff via telephone.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
