SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON MAY 3, 1974 TO DISCUSS TVA'S QUALITY ASSURANCE ORGANIZATION WITH REGULATORY MANAGEMENT

On May 3, 1974, representatives of TVA met with Regulatory management to appeal the staff's position on TVA's QA organization. This position was discussed with TVA in a meeting held on April 19, 1974 and concerned the dual roles of field engineering and inspection associated with the Construction Engineer and his staff within TVA's Division of Construction.

The history of previous TVA and staff discussions was summarized and TVA presented arguments for the adequacy of the BNP QA organization as modified by presentations in the April 19, 1974 meeting. In this presentation TVA stipulated that the Construction Engineer and his staff of field engineers will make no judgement of acceptance of inspection findings which are not within the literal limits of specifications and their tolerances as defined by the design engineering organizations.

This was counter to the staff's previous understanding which had lead to establishment of the staff position in our April 26, 1974 letter. Since TVA stipulated in this meeting that the inspection functions of the field engineers would not be compromised by their field engineering duties, the matter was resolved by both TVA and the Regulatory staff.

No additional documentation other than this meeting summary and that which was required by the organizational changes presented in the April 19, 1974 meeting was determined to be required.
