Subject: ISSUANCE OF LIMITED WORK AUTHORIZATION TO TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY FOR THE BELLEFONTE NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

Pursuant to an order issued by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board we have issued a limited work authorization (LWA) to the Tennessee Valley Authority authorizing certain work to be performed on the site of the proposed Bellefonte Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2 prior to the issuance of a construction permit by the Commission. The LWA dated September 17, 1974 was issued three months prior to the prospective date of issuance of a construction permit.

LIMITED WORK AUTHORIZATION (LWA) FOR TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY REGARDING EARLY SITE PREPARATION FOR THE BELLEFONTE NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

As a result of favorable ASLB findings on environmental considerations and site suitability and Regulatory staff determinations that an LWA should be issued, the attached letter to the Applicant and a memorandum to the Office of the Secretary transmitting a Notice of Limited Work Authorization have been prepared.

A favorable ASLB Initial Decision on environmental and site suitability considerations was issued on September 6, 1974.

The Office of Antitrust and Indemnity (OAI) has found that there are no antitrust issues that would constitute good cause for denying, limiting or delaying issue of an LWA and that Tennessee Valley Authority is financially qualified to design and construct the proposed facility to be known as the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2.

Accordingly, the staff recommends you sign the enclosed LWA.
