## MEETING SUMMARY

DATE: March 31, 2011

### PURPOSE:

To discuss the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's review of the U.S. Army Installation Management Command's (IMCOM's) request to continue operations during the NRC staff's review of IMCOM's license application for a source material license and the Radiation Safety Plan (RSP) supporting the request.

### DISCUSSION:

The NRC staff discussed its review of the RSP and requested clarification on several technical issues associated with the plan. The Army staff provided clarification on several issues, but due to the nature of the staff's comments, it was determined that the RSP would need to be revised to include additional information. The NRC staff indicated that it would provide its comments to the Army in a Request for Additional Information (RAI) and the Army would address each issue as a response to the RAI or as a revision to the RSP. At the conclusion of the technical discussion, the NRC staff addressed questions from several members of the public. Although the NRC staff was able to address the majority of the questions, several members of the public questioned the number of depleted uranium (DU) rounds that were believed to be at the Hawaiian (HI) ranges. The NRC staff stated that it would review any information that the public had regarding the number of rounds at the HI ranges.

### ACTIONS:

NRC staff will provide the Army with its comments on the RSP in an RAI. The Army will develop responses to the RAIs and either provides a written response or revise the RSP.

If the public provides the NRC staff with additional information regarding the number of rounds at the HI ranges the NRC staff will review it to determine if it impacts the RSP or the licensing of the HI sites.
