BELLEFONTE NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO VIOLATION - 50-438/84-03-01, 50-439/84-03-01 - FAILURE TO FOLLOW PROCEDURES FOR CONCRETE EXPANSION ANCHOR BOLTS AND PIPE SUPPORT INSPECTIONS

TVA's initial response to R. C. Lewis' letter dated February 29, 1984, report numbers 50-438/84-03 and 50-439/84-03, concerning activities at the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant which appeared to have been in violation of NRC regulations was submitted on March 30, 1984. This was followed by our supplemental response submitted on August 3, 1984. Below is our second supplemental response.

As discussed with NRC-OIE Inspector Paul Fredrickson of October 30, 1984, the date of October 31, 1984 for completion of corrective actions indicated in our final report on this matter would not be met. Due to the length of Quality Control Procedure (QCP) 2.8, TVA had considered splitting this QCP into two separate procedures. Although this alternative is no longer being considered, the revision of QCP 2.8 has subsequently been delayed. The corrective action on this matter will be completed by January 11, 1985.
