AN ELECTRICAL PANEL COMPONENT


TVA responded to R. C. Lewis' letter dated February 17, 1984, report numbers 50-438/84-01 and 50-439/84-01, concerning activities at the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant which appeared to have been in violation of NRC regulations by letter dated March 14, 1984. This was followed by our supplemental report dated September 12, 1984. Below is our second supplemental response to the citation.

As discussed with NRC-OIE Inspector P. E. Fredrickson on October 12, 1984, the date of October 15, 1984, for completion of corrective actions indicated in our final report on this matter would not be met. The issuance of the relevant Quality Control Procedures has been delayed due to their complexity. These procedures are now in various stages of the approval cycle.
