Recently, Crow Butte Resources Inc. dba Cameco Resources (Cameco) has evaluated the option of using pipelines to transport all process fluids, from the Three Crow Expansion Area to the main Crow Butte Plant in lieu of constructing a full satellite facility. As a result, Cameco has decided to undertake the necessary licensing action that will allow construction and operation of this process pipelines.

To accomplish this, Cameco requests that NRC suspend review of the Three Crow Expansion Area license amendment application so that Cameco may supplement the application with the alternate approach.

A written request to this effect will follow. Cameco is also preparing a schedule for submission of the supplemental information and will provide the schedule in the near future.
