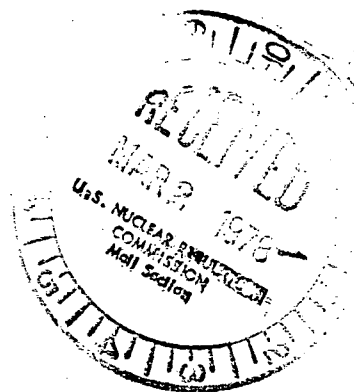

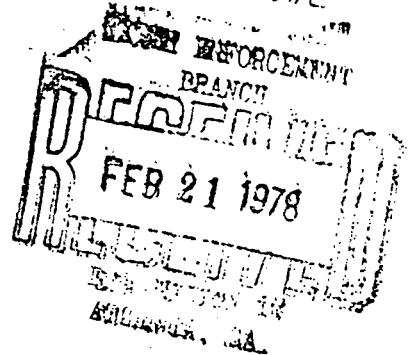

This is in reference to your letter of November 10, 1977, to Dr. Peter A. Krenkel, concerning the above-referenced facilities and further updates the schedules for submittal of supplemental information given to you by James S. Morris of my staff on November 30, 1977. As discussed with you, we have also included the schedule for submittal of information for the Watts Bar plant. The supplemental information includes both thermal and nonthermal data, as necessary, to complete the NPDES permits. Our present schedules are:

Watts Bar Nuclear Plant - February 21, 1978  
Sequoyah Nuclear Plant - March 15, 1978  
Bellefonte Nuclear Plant- May 1, 1978  
✓Hartsville Nuclear Plant- July 1, 1978

We will include with the additional information for the Sequoyah plant a detailed description of a proposed mixing zone. As discussed with you and Mr. Jack McCormick, of the Tennessee Division of Water Quality Control, we will be prepared to conduct an onsite briefing related to this proposal for interested EPA and Tennessee Division of Water Quality Control staff, as well as any Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff who wish to participate. If possible, we would like to schedule this briefing for a satisfactory time within two or three weeks from your receiving the mixing zone report.


