

<p style="text-align: center;">PROGRAM SCOPE</p> <p>The licensee is authorized to use H-3, and C-14, for research and development as defined by Section 30.4 of 10 CFR Part 30. At the time of the inspection, the licensee was no longer in business to conduct licensed activities due to a lawsuit and involuntary receivership. The only licensed material possessed by the licensee is two generally-licensed gas chromatographs, which have been leak-tested as required. No licensed activities had been conducted at the authorized location of use. The licensee has recently emerged from receivership and the company's assets were sold to a new company. The RSO informed the inspector that a change of ownership has been submitted to NRC and was waiting approval and license amendment. Since no licensed activities had been initiated, the next inspection date was extended only for one year in accordance with Manual Chapter 2800.</p>
