Dear Mr. Sivak,

I was in the process of writing your license and I noticed that you have requested for Dr. Harris to be authorized to use Iodine-131 in doses not to exceed 33 millicuries. I was able to confirm with the state of Washington that Dr. Harris was authorized for 35.300 to include iodine-131 -without restriction on the dose- on the Washington state license included in your application.

Based on the pre-licensing visit it appears to me that you wanted to have the flexibility of performing several different nuclear medicine procedures to avoid having your patients having to travel to Missoula or Kalispell form such treatments. Please note, treatments like thyroid carcinomas can normally require a dose range between 100-150 millicuries of Iodine-131. The way it is requested in your application would limit you to doses not to exceed 33 millicuries. Thus, not allowing you to perform treatments like thyroid carcinomas.

Please confirm if you want Dr. Harris to be authorized for Iodine-131 without the 33 millicuries restriction so that you can have the ability to perform other patient treatment were a dose greater than 33 millicuries is required.

Also, please note that although you have requested 35.300 and Iodine-131 in separate line items they will not be separate line items on the license. Iodine-131 use is included under the 35.300 use. Adding both maximum possession limits results in a total of 599 millicuries.

Please confirm if I may round up the maximum possession limit to 600 millicuries or if you prefer the maximum possession limit to remain as 599 millicuries.
