Due to a change in NRC licensing policy, total possession limits for all regulated materials need to be listed on NRC licenses. As we discussed by telephone on March 21, 2011, and based on the information you provided, we have listed the total possession limit for cesium-137 and americium-241 on your license. If in the future your needs change and you require additional regulated material, you will need to request an amendment to your NRC license.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to your NRC license as a result of this change in licensing policy. Please carefully review these changes.
