We received your amendment request on February 7, 2011, pertaining to the use of sulfuric acid in place of hydrochloric acid in the yellowcake precipitation process at Uranium One's Irigaray Central Processing Plant and for a clarification of the necessary technical qualifications for the Radiation Safety Technician as in NRC Regulatory Guide 8.31. Your request has been accepted for technical review.

Please note that an acceptance review does not constitute a complete technical review. The ongoing technical review may identify areas within the application requiring additional information or clarification. NRC staff anticipates that a request for additional information or clarification will be requested no later than 90 days of the date of this letter.
