Cathy,

We called today and also left you a voicemail, however, I wanted to follow up with an email as well.

We received a phone call today from a gentleman who said that he had our troxler gauge No. 33784, which we reported stolen in November 2007. We went and retrieved the gauge. When we got there, we surveyed the area and inspected the gauge for damage. The survey produced a reading of less than 1 millirem / hour at a distance of 1 meter, and the gauge had no physical damage and the tungsten slide block was in place and closed. Upon getting the gauge back to our facilities, we leak tested the gauge and have sent the leak test out via UPS. The gauge is now in storage.

We originally called the USNRC today and informed them of the recovery, as they were the ones that we originally notified when the incident took place, as NJ was not an agreement state at the time. We spoke to Mr. Sattar Lodhi today and he directed us to you to close out this event.

We have called the USNRC Operations Center, Local Police Department, Troxler Electronics and Instr-Tek and notified them that we have retrieved the gauge, all of which we originally notified at the time the gauge was stolen.
