Dear Mr. Johnson:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 03 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-26193-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that we reduced the per source limit in Items 8. A and B to 9 and 44 millicuries respectively for cesium-137 and americium-241. These changes were necessary to match the maximum activity values allowed in the Sealed Source and Device Registry for the Troxler Model 3400 Series.

We also updated your NRC Material License by modifying License Condition Nos. 13, 14, 16, and 17 as they appeared in Amendment No. 02. We removed License Condition No. 15 as is appeared in Amendment No. 02 as it is now considered redundant after we modified License Condition No. 17.

Lastly we added Condition No. 19 as it appears in your current license. This license conditions restricts the licensee from altering sealed sources without obtaining the proper authorizations. These changes should enhance your awareness of regulatory requirements and the radiation safety program elements in your license.



You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
