SUBJECT: PROPOSED EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FREQUENTLY ASKED
QUESTION PROCESS

Dear Ms. Perkins-Grew:

On February 17, 2011, the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) transmitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a draft of NEI 11-03, Revision 0, "Emergency Preparedness Frequently Asked Question Process," dated March 2011, to support implementation of the proposed emergency preparedness (EP) rule (www.regulations.gov; Docket No. 2008-0122). This proposed EP frequently asked question (FAQ) process was discussed with NEI and Industry representatives at a March 1, 2011, public meeting. The draft NEI 11-03 document and the March 1, 2011, meeting summary are available in the Agencywide Document Access and Management System under Accession No. ML110480900.

The NRC staff plan to expand its current FAQ process used to clarify emergency action level guidance, to be similar to the FAQ process used for Part 26 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*. Copies of this revised process and associated sample web pages are enclosed. Therefore, the NRC is not endorsing NEI 11-03. The NRC staff expects that NEI will continue to coordinate the review and screening of Industry FAQs in accordance with the criteria outlined in the enclosed process.
