Subject: Request for additional information about change of Radiation Safety Officer

We had received a letter from Dr. Jordan, notifying the NRC that he has resigned as the RSO for The Harold Leever Regional Cancer Center (HLRCC). He also attached a letter to InSight Imaging, notifying that he has resigned his responsibilities as RSO for the InSight-managed PET-CT operation at HLRCC. I asked Dr. Jordan if he also resigning as the RSO for InSight Imaging, but he said he would remain the InSight RSO. I asked what was meant by the reference of the InSight-managed PET-CT operations at HLRCC. He said that initially HLRCC had used InSight Imaging for mobile PET-CT operations. Once they had established that there was a need for a full-time facility, InSight helped HLRCC apply for the license, get their equipment, etc. He said that HLRCC owned all of the equipment, the license, employed the authorized users, etc. He said that InSight is contracted to provide PET Operations, including providing the technologists and the Radiation Safety Officer. I asked if the InSight bankruptcy affected the HLRCC. He said no—they were a completely separate entity. He also said that InSight Imaging wasn't affected by the bankruptcy. He said that it was the parent company of the parent company (the holding company) that was in bankruptcy and that the financial restructuring had already been completed. InSight Imaging was not affected and they have not had any budgetary restrictions.
