Karen McGuire contacted us for clarification on two questions we asked with respect to their new license request. Karen explained that the material being requested is classified information and did not think that they would be able to provide a specific amount of material that would be possessed. She was informed that our licenses are written such that a possession limit must be specified. It was explained to Ms. McGuire that the request specified that material would be possessed in encased packages as well as in waste contamination and that she would need to specify limits for both. She was also informed that financial assurance may be required. In the RAI issued to the potential licensee, we asked for specific information about transuranics that may be present. We explained to Ms. McGuire that we would need to know what the intended contaminants were and that they may need to be a separate line item listed in the license and may also require separate financial assurance and could move the license into a different fee category. Ms. McGuire stated that she had information about the transuranics that were present and would send, via e-mail, a laboratory report which lists them and the amount present. Ms. McGuire is the RSO for another Dept of Army license and she stated she did not have to list a specified amount for the material or list the transuranic material. In addition to sending us the report, she will also reference the other licenses so that we may discuss with the licensing region for understanding and consistency.
