2. Physical Description

Twenty (20) MFC shipping containers, each of which contains two (2) fuel assemblies for a total of forty (40) fuel assemblies. The shipment contains nominally 18,382 KgU and 746 Kg²³⁵U at an average enrichment of approximately 4.06 wt% U²³⁵. The MFC's are loaded onto ten flat rack containers.

3. Transport Route

The shipment will depart from Oakland, CA via the vessel "Ever Reach" going to Tokyo, Japan. Upon arrival at Tokyo, Kansai Electric Power Co., or its agent, will take physical custody of the shipment as arranged prior to shipment.

4. Schedule

The shipment is scheduled to depart Richland on February 15, 2011 and to depart Oakland, CA on February 19, 2011 and is expected to arrive at Tokyo on March 2, 2011. The shipment will depart Tokyo on March 2, 2011 and arrive at Kansai Electric Power Co. Inc., Takahama Unit 4 on March 2, 2011.

5. Assurance

The shipment will be protected during transport in accordance with IAEA Information Circular 225, "Physical Protection of Nuclear Materials".
