In response to Robert W. Sharkey's e-mail to me, dated April 20, 2011, requesting an extension of the period of time for AREVA NP, Inc., Mount Athos Road Facility to reply to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Request for Additional Information (RAI), dated April 1, 2011, the NRC hereby grants an extension to May 20, 2011. The April 1, 2011, RAI specified a reply time of 30 days. However, Mr. Sharkey stated that the letter had just arrived and that a full 30-day period would be required to respond to the large number of RAIs discussed. We look forward to receiving the RAI replies on or before May 20, 2011.
