Dear Mr. Ritter:

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your notification of cessation of principal activities under the license listed above. You stated that you would cease activity by September 30, 2011. In accordance with 10 CFR Part 30.36, we expect decommissioning of the facility to be completed within 24 months unless a decommissioning plan is submitted within 12 months and an alternate schedule is approved. In accordance with the conditions of your license, a decommissioning plan is not required unless decommissioning activities are required which are not currently authorized by your license.

Current NRC guidance for decommissioning is in NUREG-1757, "Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance", Volumes 1, 2 and 3. In particular, you should review NUREG-1757, Volume 2, Appendix B, "Simple Approaches for Conducting Final Radiological Surveys".
