Dear Dr. Petrella:

Due to a change in NRC licensing policy, total possession limits for all regulated materials need to be listed on NRC licenses. As I discussed by telephone on March 24, 2011, with John Hoyle and based on the information he provided, we have listed the total possession limit for iodine-131 on your license. If in the future your needs change and you require additional regulated material, you will need to request an amendment to your NRC license. Mr. Hoyle and I also discussed the necessity for a Suite No. in License Condition No. 10.A. and Mr. Hoyle stated that there was no need for a Suite No. to be listed. Therefore, the Suite No. was removed from License Condition No. 10.A.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to your NRC license as a result of this change in licensing policy. Please carefully review these changes.
