
Due to a change in NRC licensing policy, total possession limits for all regulated materials need to be listed on NRC licenses. As we discussed by telephone on March 24, 2011, and based on the information you provided, we have listed the total possession limit for cesium-137 and americium-241 on your license. If in the future your needs change and you require additional regulated material, you will need to request an amendment to your NRC license.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to your NRC license as a result of this change in licensing policy. Please carefully review these changes.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
