Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license except materials in 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200. As we discussed by telephone with Rick Weaver, Nuclear Medicine Technologist on April 5, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit for the materials in 10 CFR 31.11 as 2 millicuries in Item 8.E. in a corrected copy to Amendment No. 11 to your NRC Material License No. 24-17477-01.
