Dear Dr. Mellen:

Due to a change in NRC licensing policy, total possession limits for all regulated materials need to be listed on all NRC licenses. We found that your NRC license did not contain a possession limit for iodine-131 authorized under 10 CFR 35.300. We have found that 1 curie of iodine-131 is adequate for most programs your size so we added a possession limit of 1 curie of iodine-131 on your NRC license under 10 CFR 35.300. If in the future your needs change and you require additional material under 35.300, you will need to request an amendment to your NRC license.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to your NRC license as a result of this change in licensing policy. Please carefully review these changes.
