Dear Dr. Bender:

It has come to our attention that an omission existed in Amendment No. 64 to your NRC Material License No. 21-13562-01. This omission has been corrected by the addition of a total possession limit in Item 8.E. in the enclosed Corrected Copy of License Amendment No. 64.

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license except materials in 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200. As we discussed with your physics consultant Marcia West by telephone on March 24, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit for the materials authorized in 10 CFR 31.11 as 2 millicuries in Item 8.E.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005- 31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
