Enclosed is Amendment No. 27 amending NRC Material License No. 24-00513-38 in accordance with your letter dated September 10, 2010. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

This amendment approves the release of the laboratory R-430 located on the University of Missouri – St. Louis campus for unrestricted use. Based on review of the information provided in your request, we have concluded that any residual byproduct material remaining in the facility is below the NRC's unrestricted use dose limits specified in 10 CFR Part 20, subpart E "Radiological Criteria for License Termination."

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(iii).
