Subject: Use of Expired Packaging

This e-mail is a reminder that the letter authorizations issued by the NRC for use of the expired packaging, Model Nos. 5979, 1500, and GE 100, provide NRC approval for use of the package. These expired packages are also no longer authorized under the Department of Transportation's (DOT) Hazardous Materials Regulations. Therefore, you must obtain a DOT Special Permit approval before use of the NRC authorization letter.

Use of the NRC letter authorization without an accompanying DOT Special Permit would be a failure to comply with NRC's regulatory requirements for shipment under 10 CFR 71.5.
