By the reference letter dated May 6, 2011, the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) submitted a request for amendment to the Technical Specifications (TS) for Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Unit 1. The amendment request proposed the allowance of a one-time, 31-day extension to monthly TS Surveillance Requirements 4.3.1.1.1 and 4.3.2.1.1 for certain instrument functions of the Reactor Trip System and Engineered Safety Feature Actuation System, respectively.

TVA has decided to withdraw the referenced TS Change, TS 11-06, and perform the required Surveillance test within the specified Frequency.


