Specifically, since the last inspection conducted in 2010, the licensee has not performed a periodic (at least annual) review of the radiation safety program content and implementation. This is a Severity Level IV violation (Enforcement Manual 6.3.d.3). At the conclusion of the inspection, the Manager, Inspection Services Organization, TVA and RSO provided corrective action by stating they would develop an audit plan and conduct the annual review (audit) of the entire program in 2011.
