Dear Dr. Walton:

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license. As we discussed by telephone on April 12, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit for the activation products in Item 8. H.H. as 10 microcuries in a corrected copy to Amendment No 32 to your NRC Material License No. 21-01432-02. Also, as we discussed, it appears that the list of radionuclides and their corresponding Item designations have changed. For example, currently Item 6.D. is cesium-137, but in past amendments Item 6.D. was carbon-14. It appears that we have failed to update that Item designations and radionuclides for all of the authorized users so that some of the radionuclides listed for the authorized users were incorrect. We have corrected this error and apologize of any inconvenience this may have caused.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
