Subject: Additional information for amendment requests

Both licensees submitted similar requests to name Monica Rossi as authorized medical physicist (AMP). Peter is RSO for both licenses. I contacted him to discuss additional information required. This message represents a series of e-mail communications.

Peter indicated that Monica is studying for the ABR oral examination to be conducted later this month.

I informed Peter that if Monica passes the ABR oral examination, one option is to submit information to qualify her under the board certification pathway rather than the training and experience (T&E) pathway. This would require submission of: (a) the board certificate or letter from the ABR documenting completion of certification requirements and AMP-eligibility; (b) a new preceptor attestation for the board certification pathway; and (c) documentation of completion of training on the licensees' Nucletron HDR equipment.

If the licensees prefer to continue using the T&E pathway, they should submit documentation of (a) graduate degree completion including field of major study; (b) one year of supervised work experience; (c) the University of Kentucky supervisor's status as HDR AMP; and completion of training on the licensees' Nucletron HDR equipment. An additional preceptor attestation is also needed to include the year of supervised work experience.

On 5/16/11, I requested a response within 30 days.
