Dear Ms. Cook:

The University of South Dakota NRC License currently lists five (5) sites on its license for use of licensed materials. The University is requesting that two (2) of the sites be removed from the license. These sites are identified in the license under item 10 as site C, The seventh floor of the Avera Doctor's Plaza, 1100 East 21st Street, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and site E, Sanford Research/USD, 900 West Delaware, Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

The 900 West Delaware site (item 10. E) was added to the license for potential use of licensed materials however no activities involving licensed materials have ever taken place and the site is no longer a potential site for licensed material activities.

The Avera Doctor's Plaza site (item 10. C) no longer houses any activities involving licensed materials. The final laboratory survey has been completed as of April 18th, 2011, and shows no contamination above background levels in any of the licensed material storage and use areas.


