Low levels of Cs-137 contaminated underground drain piping and soils located in Rooms 000, 001, 003C, and 003E.



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Description of project activities:

Removal of underground drain piping and soils in Rooms 000, 001, 003C, and 003E in Building 232. Drain piping and soils are contaminated with low levels of Cs-137.

Final status surveys will be performed in Rooms 000, 001, 003C, and 003E following decontamination activities.

Waste Management and disposition:

Waste materials will be packaged into two B-25 boxes 25 for disposal. Waste materials will be shipped to the Environmental Managements & Controls facility located in Turlock, CA for processing and disposal. It is anticipated that a maximum of 180 cubic feet of waste material will be generated from decontamination activities in Rooms 003C, 003E, 000, and 001.

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Description of project activities:

Decontamination of lab areas, items, and equipment located in Room 001 of Building 232. Areas, items, and equipment were contaminated with low levels of Cs-137. Items not decontaminated were packaged for disposal.

Post job surveys were performed in Room 000 and 001 following decontamination activities. All survey results were below the release criteria.

Waste Management and disposition:

Waste materials were packaged into DOT approved 55-gallon drums and a B-25 box 25 for disposal. The smoke detectors were shipped to the Air Force radioactive material recycling and disposal facility located at the Wright Patterson Air Force Base in Dayton, OH. Other waste materials were shipped to the Environmental Managements & Controls facility located in Turlock, CA for processing and disposal. Approximately 90 cubic feet of waste material was generated from decontamination activities in Rooms 000 and 001.

Complications/Unexpected encounters with radioactive materials:

Underground drain piping that leads to outside storage tanks from Rooms 000 and 001 is still in place. Will be removed at a future date.


