Don,

On this basis, the staff would like to have the core boxes opened from boring B2000, which is located at the center of Unit 3 and which has unusually complete core recovery. If space is available at the storage facility, the staff would also like the core boxes opened from boring B1000, which is at the center of Unit 3.

The staff wants only these sets of core available. The purpose of inspecting them is general familiarization with the geology, rather than a detailed review.

Also, the staff would like to see the Glen Rose Formation in outcrop. This was discussed during the phone call. One of Luminant's geologists said on the call that some good exposures were located near the plant.
