*The only open recommendation pertains to the status of our regulations. The Bureau has developed and implemented a program improvement plan to address the regulatory gaps. Progress updates have been discussed with NRC during quarterly conference calls since the last IMPEP.*

*Furthermore, we have amended all HDR, GammaKnife, Well Logging and Industrial Radiography licenses to incorporate the equivalent applicable US NRC regulations as a corrective action until 10 NYCRR 16 is amended to include these changes. Also, a license condition has been written for licensees that have a respiratory protection program so that the current protection factors are used, and a variance has been written for exempt distribution of a radioactive drug containing one microcurie of Carbon-14 Urea.*

*The only new hire in the radioactive materials section was Vanessa Danese. Ms. Danese received extensive in house training for radioactive materials licensing and inspection. Ms. Danese received a BA in Biology and successfully completed a 4 week health physics class at Baylor University. Ms. Danese resigned and accepted a position with the State of Texas radiation protection program in 2009.*

*Michael Soucie was transferred into the radioactive materials section January 2011 from our emergency response section. Mr. Soucie has an undergraduate degree in nuclear medicine technology and a master's degree in health physics. Mr. Soucie has completed the following US NRC classes: nuclear medicine, MARSSIM, and inspection procedures.*

*Messer's. Thayer and Webster are also new employees that work in other sections of the bureau. They have completed the US NRC inspection procedures class and perform fixed and portable gauge inspections. Both individuals have bachelor's degrees and have received extensive in-house on the job training. Mr. Webster completed the 4 week health physics course at Baylor University.*

*Mr. Harmon and Mr. Soucie have not attended the licensing procedures course and J. Krishanmoorthy, Ph.D. has not attended the inspection procedures course, however all have, and continue to, received on the job training from experienced staff. Scope of licensing and inspection assignments are commensurate with the level of training received. Training is ongoing.*

The Assistant Bureau Director and Chief, Radioactive Materials Section positions continue to remain open. Robert Dansereau the former Section Chief was moved to Assistant Bureau Director in June 2008 and is acting in that capacity. The Bureau has requested that Robert Dansereau and Charles Burns be promoted to the Assistant Bureau Director and Section Chief positions respectively but that request has not been approved due to the ongoing fiscal crisis. The Bureau will continue to seek to fill these essential program positions.

8. For Agreement States, does your program have an oversight board or committee which provides direction to the program and is composed of licensees and/or members of the public? If so, please describe the procedures used to avoid any potential conflict of interest.

*No. The Radiological Health Advisory Committee is defunct.*

*There are none. We recently changed medical private practice with written directive from 4 years to 3 years.*

*Please be aware that prior to October 31, 2008, all of the commercial radioactive materials licensing and inspection information was maintained on a separate database. Most of this information was migrated into the existing database, however there is information that was not or could not be captured. For example, inspection history was only limited to the last and next due inspections ( no continuous history was maintained).*

*We have attached two tables summarizing this information. A review of the Table of initial inspections performed indicates that none were performed late.*

*See attached table. Many of these licensees have no permanent storage facility in New York State. We routinely send letters to these out of state licensees to make arrangements for inspection when they work in New York State. The inspectors that have overdue inspections have been notified and arrangements are being made to complete this work.*

14. Please provide the number of reciprocity licensees that were candidates for inspection per year as described in IMC 1220 and indicate the number of reciprocity inspections of candidate licensees that were completed each year during the review period.

*We only authorize reciprocity for 30 days in a calendar year, then a NYSDOH specific radioactive materials license is required, so we capture sufficient out of state licensees for routine inspection to meet these requirements. We do perform reciprocity inspections when possible and focus on industrial radiography operations.*

*None*

*We have attached reports from our database showing evidence of supervisory accompaniments.*

17. Describe or provide an update on your instrumentation, methods of calibration, and laboratory capabilities. Are all instruments properly calibrated at the present time? Were there sufficient calibrated instruments available throughout the review period?

*We currently have sufficient numbers and types of instruments for conducting inspections and investigations. These are either calibrated at our in house facility at the NYSDOH calibration laboratory or are sent to the manufacturers for calibration annually. All instruments in use are properly calibrated. The Department's Wadsworth Center, Laboratory of Inorganic and Nuclear Chemistry provides full radiological measurement support.*

*We have attached a report from our equipment database. Please note that this is a comprehensive inventory of equipment for our bureau and some of this equipment is not in use or is used by our x-ray equipment section. Only currently calibrated equipment is used for regulatory functions.*

18. How many specific radioactive material licenses does your program regulate at this time?

*At the time of writing, there are 1,094 specific licensees.*

19. Please identify any major, unusual, or complex licenses which were issued, received a major amendment, were terminated, decommissioned, submitted a bankruptcy notification or renewed in this period.

*License termination of Proctor and Gamble which included a D&D of a multi-curie radiosynthesis lab; D&D of another multi-curie radiosynthesis laboratory at Wyeth Pharmaceuticals; and license termination and D&D of a cyclotron at IBA Molecular North America.*

*NYSDOH issued a new industrial radiography license to a new company (Sky Testing) and amended an existing license to authorize possession of a self-shielded irradiator after the initial implementation of IC and NSTS requirements. In both cases site visits were made to verify all IC requirements were in place before the respective license and amendment were issued.*

*NRD, LLC filed for bankruptcy in 2009. They subsequently emerged from bankruptcy.*

*We were recently notified that a licensee, Ordway Research Institute, has Filed Chapter 11 Bankruptcy.*

20. Discuss any variances in licensing policies and procedures or exemptions from the regulations granted during the review period.

*None, however a variance for the exempt distribution of a radioactive drug containing one microcurie of Carbon-14 urea has been written and is available.*

*We use US NRC provided guidance to determine that new unknown license applicants will use radioactive materials as requested. We also require full implementation of Increased Controls requirements prior to authorizing an initial possession of Category 1 or 2 sources.*
