Dear Mr. Chairman,

Per H.R. 1473, Sec 1478, enclosed is the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) spending plan for Fiscal Year 2011 at the program level. The NRC will implement all programs and activities as described in the FY 2011 President's Budget. The NRC plans to spend \$803,894,749 on the Nuclear Reactor Safety program, which supports regulatory activities associated with locating, licensing, and overseeing new and operating nuclear power plants. The NRC plans to spend \$239,313,725 on the Nuclear Materials and Waste Safety program, which supports regulation of uranium processing and fuel facilities, nuclear materials users, spent fuel storage, spent fuel storage cask designs and transportation packaging designs; decontamination and decommissioning of facilities; and low-level and high-level radioactive waste. The Office of the Inspector General plans to spend \$10,857,828 in FY 2011. The increase between the FY 2011 Congressional request and the FY 2011 enacted budget will fund OIG's mandatory Chief Financial Officers Act requirement to audit NRC's financial statements and pre and post contract award audits of NRC contracts performed by the Defense Contract Audit Agency.
