

8.17 RADIATION MONITORING INSTRUMENTS

1. Radiation monitoring instruments will be calibrated by a person qualified to perform survey meter calibrations.
2. Calibration will be done through the Army's Test, Measurement and Diagnostic Equipment Program, Equipment Manufacturer, or Certified Laboratory in compliance with 10 CFR 35.61.
3. The following instrumentation will be used to perform required surveys:
 - a. Gamma Counter
 - b. Portable Count Rate Meter
 - c. Portable Exposure Rate Meter
4. We reserve the right to upgrade our survey instruments as necessary as long as they are adequate to measure the type and level of radiation for which they are used."
