Attached is draft RAI 5773 prepared by the Corps of Engineers staff for the environmental review of Turkey Point Units 6 and 7. This RAI is related to the transmission line alternatives evaluation for Chapter 9. Note that the National Park Service, which recently became a cooperating agency for the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 environmental impact statement, has indicated it may want to add to or otherwise modify this RAI. However, because FPL has asked to see the Corps' request to support near-term discussions with the Corps, I'm sending it as it is written right now. I will forward any changes to the RAI once they are agreed to between the three agencies.

EIS USACE-***

This is a request for additional information regarding the Florida Power & Light (FPL) Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 application that has been assigned U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) file number SAJ-2009-02417 (IP-MLC).

As part of the consideration of the aforementioned project, the Corps submitted a request for a further in-depth alternatives analysis to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on October 29, 2010. This request was forwarded to FPL on February 1, 2011, as RAI letter 110131, RAI 5340.

As a clarification to that request, the Corps is requesting that FPL consider a third option to the western transmission line corridor, one that does not include impacts to Everglades National Park or its boundary as a form of avoidance and minimization for the on-site proposal.
